



2025 ADULT WINTER READING CHALLENGE

We'll "navigate" the North Country Trail through Minnesota by reading, listening, walking, skiing, and/ or snowshoeing for eight weeks this winter. For every 4 books you read and/or every 20 miles you trek, you complete a card/4 badges and your flag moves on to the next point on the map (flags & map in the library). Receive an umbrella for the first card/4th badge you turn in. For every card/4th badge turned in, your name will be entered into a drawing for local gift cards. Complete the whole route and your name is entered into a separate drawing. The program runs from January 6 to February 28, 2025. Have fun!
